To be eligible for the **\$500 scholarship**, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be **a fully admitted student** in any of the majors within the Department of Political Science and Criminal Justice political science, criminal justice, public administration, international studies or organizational leadership;
- 2. Be of **senior standing** by the end of the Spring semester;
- 3. Have completed a minimum of twelve hours within the Department of Political Science and Criminal Justice:
- 4. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00;
- 5. Be pursuing a career within the law enforcement; and
- 6. Have a faculty member from the Department of Political Science and Criminal Justice endorse your application.

An applicant must submit a **250-word typed essay** describing his/her career goals and reasons why he/she is interested in a law enforcement career. The essay should be attached to the application form.

The application deadline is **Friday**, **March 27 at 5 p.m.** There are two ways to submit an application:
